

ALBURY PARK ICE HOUSE

This can be found just off the main drive to Albury Park House. It was built between 100 and 200 years ago, probably when the current House was built. The reason for the Ice House being built being the absence of refrigeration in those days. The older estate workers told me that in the wintertime, when the bog garden was frozen, the ice was collected and stored for use in Albury Park House. This building is about 12 to 15 feet square, being built of brick and it has two doors set as cellar doors, surrounded by a fence to stop people falling in.
