

Killing Room.

Lairage.

Jul 1939

Cattle wanted in lairage
1 with hay racks overnight.

Lead down passage.

Rope put round neck

Lead into killing room

Rope thru' ring.

Cattle on front on floor. Nose held.

Pole axed.

Throat cut.

Stick into brain, wiggled. Turned over

2 beams for hanging carcasses + sliv

chain winched up. Several on rail Pulleys

sling ~~beam~~ slits for hooks thru legs

while hanging, hide stripped.

Special 'clip' for stripping tail.

Launched. Offal hung on rails

for Inspector next day

Tripe kept for dog food, if no

people sent to tripe dresser.

Hanging 2 days

2 barrels by tap.

"Blood hole"

skins laid out on floor

+ salted, taken by fellmonger,
then to tanner.

Pigs scalded in barrels(?)

2 hot, 1 cold. + hair stripped.

~~Lamb~~ Lamb sometimes "blown up"

To remove skin more easily, pricked

Carcass sawed in $\frac{1}{2}$ + back half (haunch)

then finished off with cleaver.

Pigs killed by cutting arteries on
either side of neck - practically instantaneously

These 2 beams took volk's sheath Total

The weight of ~ cow - could it have been
suspended between the 2?

N.C. Tabled about 12" x 10" beams

Sheep & lambs were killed by being turned

on their backs, as for shearing, and

then having their throats cut.
