



mid 19c 3 bay barn converted into a church in 1930.

Timber framed with many timbers re-used from an earlier barn, on a stone plinth, weatherboarded, with gabled, tiled roof. The lower, North door now blocked and replaced by a window, the Southern projecting porch remains with added "belfry" over and added porch and vestry to front.

Arching Queen struts, rassing braces. Replacement timbers ship-lark Oak furniture and fittings made by Charles Allen of Yew Tree College Farley Green.
