



Mid 19c. rebuild of an earlier barn. Of five unequal bays, timber framed, weatherboarded, with Welsh slate roof and two cart doors.

Set on an ironstone plinth with brick dressings, walls weatherboarded, gabled roof covered with purple slates. Wall studs are rough posts, floor of concrete. Two bays at West end are floored over, but this may have been added. Part of loft partitioned off for grain bin. High level pitching doors

Two East bays partitioned off as stable with loft over. Stable door with pitching door over. Stable window replaced by modern domestic one. Floor of square brick paviors, walls boarded.

Roof of sawn timbers with Queen posts, clasped purlins, straight wind braces, tie beams pegged to Queen posts, strapping braces.
