I John Holmes of Albury in the County of Surrey yeoman being aged and infirme of Body but of sound perfect and disposing mind and memory (Praised be God) Doe make this my last will and Testament the Seawententh day of february in the One and Thirtieth yeare of the Reigne of King Charles the Second over England etc. Annoq^{ue} Domini 1678 hereby Renouncing and making void all wills by me formerly made either by word or Deed And first I bequeath my soule to Almighty God my Creator hoping through the meritts of my Saviour Jesus Christ to have pardon of my sinnes and Everlasting life in the Kingdome of Heaven My body I Commit to the earth from whence it came To be decently buried att the discretion of my Executor herein after named And as to such Temporall Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow upon me I dispose thereof as followeth And first whereas my late Master Roger Duncumbe Esquire deceased did in his life time Justly owe unto me the summe of Three Hundred and ffifty poundes of lawfull English money with interest thereof for severall yeares I doe hereby Release and discharge The Executors of the said Roger Duncumbe of any from the said debt and interest And my will is that the same shall goe Towards raising portions for the younger Children of him the said Roger Duncumbe And whereas I have a Rent Charge of ffive pound per Annum issuing out of the Landes of John

 estimation in Chertsey in the said County And Two Copyhold Messuages or
 Tenements with their appurtenances in Chertsey of record now in the Tenure
 of Thomas Detton gent. or of his Assignes (which said Copyhold Landes
 and Tenements are already by me Surrendered To the use of my last will and
 Testament) I doe hereby give and bequeath the said Rent Charge ffreshold
 and Copyhold Landes and Tenements with their appurtenances And all my
 Right Title and interest therein and thereto unto Richard Symmes of Guildes-
 ford in the said County gent. his heires executors Administrators and
 assignes for ever Alsoe I give to the poore of Albury Tenn pounds I give
 to Mrs. Anne Duncumb widow the summe of One hundred pounds, To Henry
 Duncumb Esquire one Ring of the value of Tenn pounds To the ffive younger
 Children of the said Roger Duncumb One Hundred pounds a piece To Mrs
 Dorothy Randall the summe of Twenty pounds To Doctor John Windebank
 the summe of Tenn pounds To my Brother Richard Holmes his ffower
 Children the summe of ffive pounds a piece And of this my last will and
 Testament I make Constitute ordeyne and appoint the said Richard Symmes
 sole Executor To whom after my debts and ffunerall Expences discharged
 and Legacies paid I give all and every my goodes and Chattells debts mortgages
 and Credits whatsoever In witness whereof I have hereunto sett my
 hand and seale the day and yeare ffirst above written. The make of John
